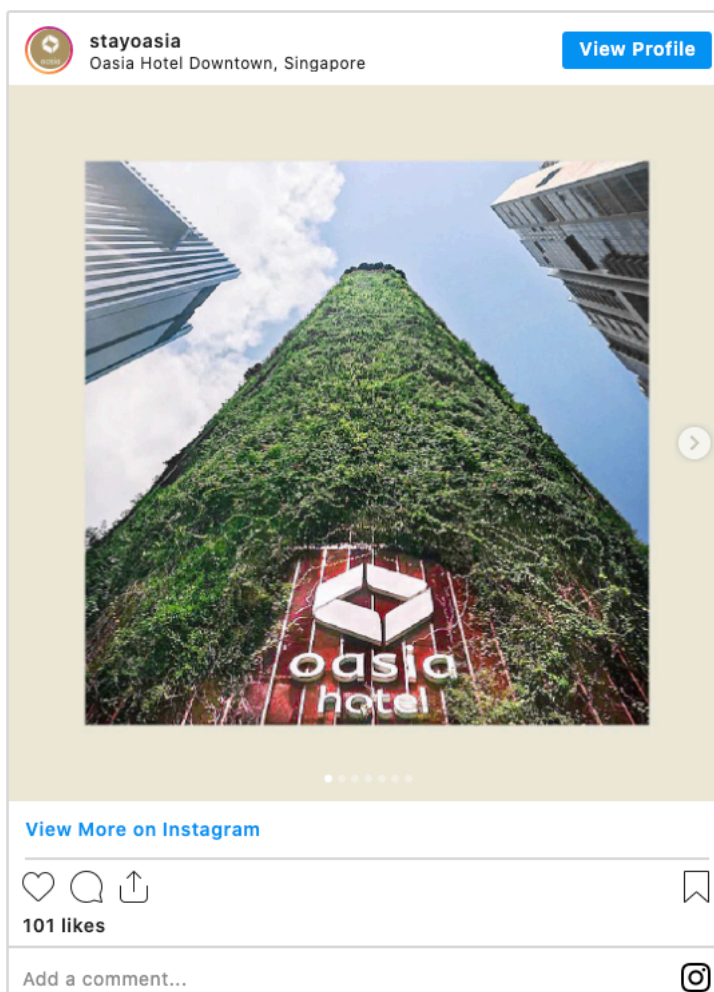

Oasia Hotel Downtown
